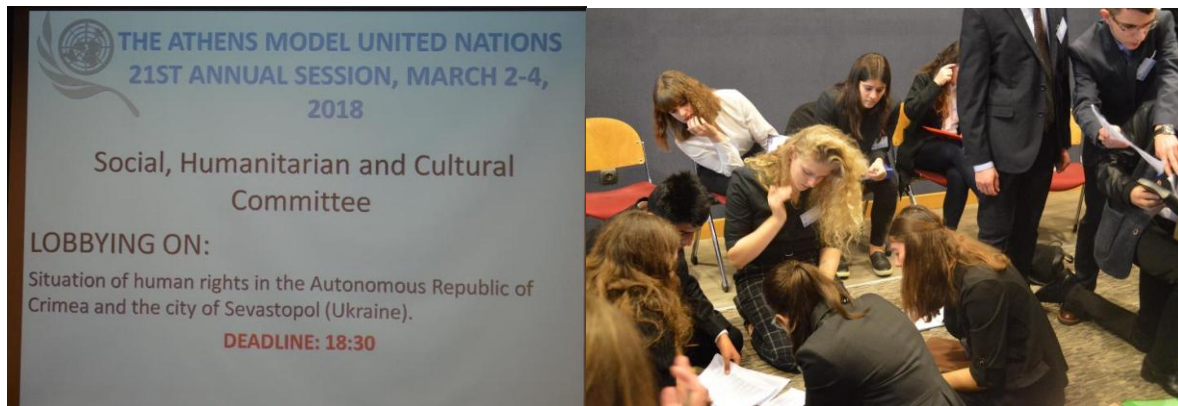
MARCH 2-4, 2018

On 2 January 2018, a ceremony of exchanging the national flags of states, which that day became the new non-permanent members of the UN Security Council, took place at the UN Headquarters in New York.

Our delegates: Anastasia Michalopoulou, Maria Aphrodite Sypsa and Lydia Christina Wallace.

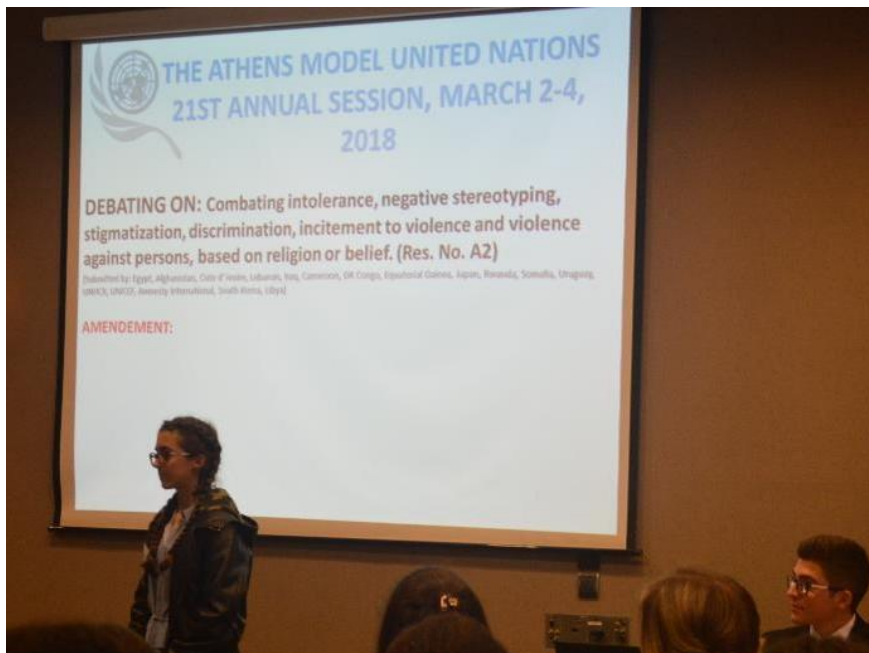


Our delegation was represented in the **Security Council** discussing the situation in the North Korea which promotes military power but its community survives under the level of poverty. They had to appoint a UN high coordinator to evaluate and monitor the situation and suggest sanctions and relevant diplomatic action.

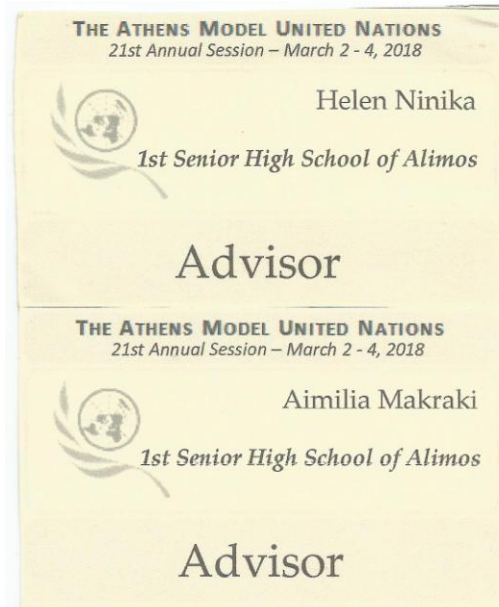
In the **General Assembly, Committee on Disarmament and International Security** issues such as the use or threat of use of nuclear weapons and developments in information and telecommunications in the context of international security, were addressed.



In the ***Social Humanitarian and Cultural Committee*** issues on combating intolerance, negative stereotyping, discrimination, stigmatisation and violence against persons, based on religion or belief, as well as the situation of human rights in Crimea and the city of Sevastopol were discussed.



There was also a *UN Conference on Preventing and Combating Terrorism, the situation in Myanmar, Combating desertification and land degradation*(to mention but a few of the rest of the issues).
