


1st Senior High School of Alimos in AMUN 2017

This year it was a special conference as AMUN was celebrating its 20th anniversary in Athens and the Opening Ceremony at Novotel Hotel was devoted to this.









It all started back in 1998 from the UN Information Centre (UNIC), situated then in Athens and Gontika Mirka (UNIC's programmes' officer) and Feliou Georgia (UNIC's librarian). UNIC closes in 2003 and a group of former fervent delegates with the help and support of Marangopoulos Foundation for Human Rights http://www.mfhr.gr/, start the MUN Organisation as we know it today.







This year, issues of international importance were addressed, with the **refugee crisis** being at the top of the agenda. After doing research and using the official site of AMUN, following the news on reliable news sources, they wrote their **resolutions**, prepared an **ambassador speech** and produced **policy statements**.


